Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos"

By METRO / UNDERGROUND

You will board the Metro from the Airport's Station and get off at Syntagma Station. At Syntagma Station you switch lines in the direction of Ag. Dimitrios and get off at the first Station, the "Acropolis Station". From Acropolis Station the Hotel is 100m away, walking along Ath. Diakou Street.

The approximate time from the Athens International Airport to the Hotel is 25 minutes.

By TAXI

The approximate time from the Airport to the Hotel is 35-40 minutes and the fare including all charges between 06:00-23:00 is approximately 60,00 €. From 23:00 till 06:00 the fare including all charges is approximately 70,00 €. Private taxi transfer arranged by the hotel.

Weather in Athens in October

October is an excellent time to visit Athens, especially toward the beginning of the month. The average high-temperature, in October, in Athens, Greece, is 23.5°C (74.3°F), while the average low-temperature is 15.9°C (60.6°F).

In the picturesque area of Plaka, just a few meters from the well-known steps of Monsikleus, at the intersection of Erechtheos and Erotokritou Streets, it is located in a beautifully landscaped neoclassical building, the historic restaurant “Palia Taverna tou Psara” (“Old Fisherman’s Tavern”) since 1898.
