Tuesday 13th – Thursday 15th of October

Leuven (Belgium)



The EQALM symposium 2026 will be held in Leuven from 13th to 15th of October. Note that the symposium will start on a Tuesday and end on a Thursday.

Leuven, situated about 30km east of Brussels, is a historic city in Belgium. It is famous for its gothic architecture, the home of KU Leuven, one of the oldest universities in Europe, and the home of the world's largest beer brewer.

The symposium will be held in the Provinciehuis (Provincieplein 1, 3010 Leuven), situated at the edge of the city center. The Provinciehuis is at walking distance from the railway station of Leuven and the main proposed hotels.



How to get to Leuven?

The main airport nearby Leuven is Brussels Airport (BRU). To go from the airport (station: Brussels Airport) to Leuven, there are two trains per hour and the train ride takes 13 minutes.

Belgium is also accessible by high speed trains. The main entrance station is Brussel Zuid (Bruxelles-Midi). This station is connected with Leuven by 4 trains per hour and a train ride lasts 27 to 29 minutes.

Proposed hotels

Please note that the venue this year is not a conference hotel. A selection of hotels is conveniently located nearby.

Park Inn hotel (Martelarenlaan 36, Leuven, 3010 Leuven). This is the hotel closest to the symposium venue.

Novotel Leuven (Vuurkruisenlaan 4, 3000 Leuven). This hotel is about 1km from the Provinciehuis.

Ibis Leuven Centrum (Brusselsestraat 52, 3000 Leuven). This hotel is in the center of Leuven, at 1.7km from the Provinciehuis.
